



**Employment Opportunity  
Gasification Technician - Full Time**

Sucker Creek First Nation is looking for an experienced Gasification Technician person to join our team.

Under the supervision of the Housing Director; the Gasification Technician is responsible for performing installation, location, inspection, repairs and maintenance of gas lines, gas equipment such as meters, regulators, and appliances in residential, commercial, and industrial environments.

The Technician is also required to perform his/her duties in compliance with Sucker Creek First Nation policies and procedures and within federal, provincial, and local codes and guidelines.

**DUTIES:**

- Apply advanced technical knowledge in the installation and service of complex residential and commercial propane and natural gas related equipment. This will include, but is not limited to line locations, repairs, inspections and re-qualifying cylinders, the installation and service of propane tanks and propane and natural gas appliances.
- Installation and location of distribution extensions, service lines and necessary repairs to the system.
- Provision of preventative maintenance solutions and scheduled maintenance for residential and commercial applications and customers.
- Respond to customer requests for service covering such items as odor fumes, inform and instruct customer of conditions of appliances, shut off any unsafe appliance at gas cock and complete the necessary documents as required.
- Perform annual premises surveys for public buildings and complete necessary reports.
- Assist in developing, revisiting, and maintaining procedural and operations manuals.
- To practice good housekeeping and routine maintenance in respect to properties and report any items requiring attention.
- Safe operation and maintenance of the service truck, excavator, skid steer and other service equipment.
- A daily journal must be filled out each day and at least once a week work orders done for each day recording hours work and mileage.
- All meter changes, customer requests etc. must be filled out immediately after each job, and meter reading each month.
- Complete invoices and work orders after each job.
- May be required to perform other duties aside from those outlined above from time to time.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Provincial certificates (Gasfitter's ticket, Utility Operators ticket, Fusion ticket) and record of training are required.
- 2-3 years' experience in a Natural Gas Service Technician role or similar capacity.
- Advanced technical knowledge of propane and natural gas appliances, equipment, and plant operations.
- WHMIS and TDG training and certification.
- Ability to multitask in a high volume, fast-paced work environment.
- Team player with a high level of self-motivation and the ability to set and meet goals.
- Thorough familiarity with word processing, spreadsheet, and project scheduling computer applications
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Must provide a Criminal Record Check (CPIC), Child Welfare Information Systems (CWIS) check and a Drivers Abstract.
- Valid Driver's License/own a reliable vehicle.
- Ability to speak Cree is an asset.
